POLICY STATEMENT #6 (PS #6)

TITLE: Use of MVPC Funds for Non-Budget Purposes (recognition of club members)

EFFECTIVE: March 9, 2021

AUTHORIZED BY: Minnesota Valley Photography Club Board

POLICY: The use of MVPC funds for non-budget purposes for the recognition of club members who go above and beyond ordinary volunteering must be controlled. Individual requests should be referred to the board. A maximum, up to and including \$100, can be expended for this purpose.

PURPOSE: To insure fiscal guidelines are adhered to in the use of club funds and the funds are used in the club's interest.

PROCEDURE: Any member can make a request to the board through email or in person at a monthly board meeting. The board will decide if the recipient should receive a monetary award or gift and determine the amount of funds, if any, to be used from the MVPC treasury for the recognition of club members who have volunteered their time extensively. This process occurs on an "as needed" basis. If the decision needs to be made quickly, an email vote can be done by the board. Once the approval process is complete, the president or his/her designee will delegate the treasurer to release the funds for the determined need or purchase.
